1. Roll the Die and resolve its effect









Reveal Chill Card May play one THEN Move Bob

Paint to Palette

May take one **Art Supplies**

May take one extra Action

2. Perform 3 Actions

(any order/multiples allowed)

- Draw/Take Art Supplies Card (1 Action per card)
- Take face-up "Any Color" card (2 Actions per card)
- Apply Paint to Your Palette
- (1 Action per card)
- Wash Your Palette

- (1 Action per paint area)
- Sweep Art Supplies Cards
- (1 Action per sweep)
- · Earn a Technique Card (1 Action per card earned)
 - Discard two cards from Hand that match Technique Card
 - Place Technique Card in front of you
 - Score 2 Chill Points
- Paint a Feature

(1 Action per feature)

- Must have required Paints on Palette from one or both paint areas.
 - Separation of mixed Paints is not allowed...
- Must have required Brush in Hand
- 1. Discard all above cards from Hand and Palette
- 2. Score 1 Chill Point per Paint required
- 3. Place Feature Marker on first empty space on Game Board
- 4. Score possible bonus points:
 - First player to paint the feature: 2 Chill Points
 - Second player to paint the feature: 1 Chill Point
 - Bob Bonus: Paint the feature before Bob? Check Bob Track
 - · Chill Card Bonus: Check active Chill Card
 - Technique Bonus: 1 Chill Point per matching Technique Card in front of you

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Finishing a Painting

As soon as one player has painted all three features of the Painting Panel on the Easel OR



Bob moves onto the last space on the Bob Track of that Painting Panel, that Painting is considered *finished*.

Immediately:

- 1. Award any "Paint a Feature" Chill Points (if applicable)
- 2. Turn over the next Painting Panel from the top of the deck and place on Easel
- 3. Place the Bob Mover on first space of the Bob Track
- 4. Return all Feature Markers on Game Board to owners
- 5. Resume the turn of the current player

Ending the Game

As soon as one player reaches the "Chill" space on the Chill Meter, the game ends at that player is the winner!

But let's face it, you're playing a Bob Ross game, so really...

Everyone's a winner!
